

Earth observation data as an early warning system can make a crucial contribution to the preservation of cultural heritage (CH). However, there is still a lack of awareness about the possibilities and knowledge about how to use it, as the workforce in cultural heritage preservation is not yet qualified to collect and analyse data and take preventive measures. The **SATCULT** project investigates and records the conditions under which CH organisations can acquire the necessary knowledge through vocational training. Funded by the European ERASMUS+ programme, this is an opportunity to make employees, networks and initiatives in CH preservation and their training providers aware of the immense potential of earth observation data and the translation of data into concrete action.
